## Order No. 04-81-3

## California Bighorn Sheep Zoological Area

## Inyo National Forest

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited in the California Bighorn Sheep Zoological area:

- (1) To go into, or be upon the Zoological Area without a valid visitor use permit, 36 CFR 261.1(a).
  - (a) To go into, or be upon the closed portion of the Mt. Baxter Unit as shown in Exhibit A, 36 CFR 261.53(a).
  - (b) To go into, or be upon the closed portion of the Mt. Williamson Unit as shown in Exhibit B. The daily entry quota (day use or overnight trips) for the George Creek trailhead is six (6) people per day during the times the route is open as shown in Exhibit B, 36 CFR 261.53(a).
- (2) Possessing, transporting, or allowing entrance of a dog or dogs, 36 CFR 261.58(s).
- (3) To discharge a firearm except in taking game animals legally permitted by the State of California, 36 CFR 261.58(m).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) each of the following persons is exempted from this order:

- (1) Persons with a visitor permit authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission, 36 CFR 261.50(e)(1).
- (2) Any federal, state, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty, 36 CFR 261.50(e)(4).

This order supersedes Order No. 04-80-2, issued on April 27, 1980.
